**Proposition 1B Goods Movement Emission Reduction Program** 



The San Diego Air Pollution Control District will have approximately <u>SIX MILLION DOLLARS</u> <u>AVAILABLE</u> to California truck owners\* to replace or repower their older, polluting, and aging diesel trucks to newer, cleaner, and more efficient equipment!

Applications for funding will be accepted from August 26 to October 10, 2013.

District staff will be available at the following times to provide answers and FREE one-on-one assistance in English and Spanish to interested owners looking to apply. <u>Don't forget to bring the documents listed on the back of this notice to help you prepare your application!</u>

#### \* IMPORTANT:

- Single truck owners are not eligible for funding unless current truck has 1994-1995 model year engine or is already equipped with a diesel particulate filter retrofit.
- Trucks subject to the ARB Drayage Truck Regulation are not eligible for funding.

	<b>Copy of old vehicle title</b> (If a lien is on the title at time of application, a copy of the title may be submitted at a later date after the lien has been paid in full, and prior to any payment of funds)		
	Copy of current DMV Registration		
	<b>DMV Vehicle Registration Information Record (Form INF 1125)</b> (The DMV printout may be obtained by submitting a Request for Driver Record Information form (INF 1125) to the DMV. To find your local DMV office, please visit <u>http://www.dmv.ca.qov</u> . You may also obtain and pay for the DMV		
	Photograph of the manufacturer's tag in the door jamb of the truck showing VIN and GVWR (Legibly printed photos only)		
	<b>One (1) mileage record showing an odometer reading prior to February 26, 2013.</b> (Acceptable documentation includes, but is not limited to, maintenance records, Biennial Inspection of Terminals (BIT inspection), International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) records, daily logs, etc.) Documentation must clearly identify the truck by ID number, license plate, or VIN.)		
	<b>One (1) PTO record (if applicable) showing hour meter reading prior to February 26, 2013</b> (Acceptable documentation is subject to approval by the District, but must clearly identify the truck by ID number, license plate, or VIN.)		
	<b>One (1) mileage record showing the current odometer reading</b> (Date on record must be within 30 days of application submittal. Acceptable documentation includes, but is not lim- ited to, maintenance records, Biennial Inspection of Terminals (BIT inspection), International Fuel Tax Agreement (IFTA) records, daily logs, etc.) Documentation must clearly identify the truck by ID number, license plate, or VIN)		
	<b>One (1) PTO record (if applicable) showing current hour meter reading</b> (Record must be dated within 30 days of application submittal. Acceptable documentation is subject to approval by the District, but must clearly identify the truck by ID number, license plate, or VIN.)		
	Proof of insurance for the past 24 months		
	<b>Printout of your TRUCRS Compliance Status page</b> Access your TRUCRS account and click on "Compliance Status". The Compliance Status page should appear showing <i>Business Information</i> and <i>General Fleet and Compliance Information</i> . Please print the entire page.
