Strategic Plan Priority Areas

- Internal review of the 2026-28 strategic plan is underway (PMP milestone, advisory input due later this year)
- Five core strategies:
 - Grow relationships with local organizations
 - Improve events & resources to attract stakeholders
 - Grow SDRCCC staff capacity
 - Diversify funding beyond Clean Cities (grants/FOAs)
 - Assist 4+ fleets per year with electrification

Stakeholder Mapping Update

- Reviewed all 22 years of SDRCCC annual reports (2004-2025) to identify every organization we've ever reported as a stakeholder
- Identified partner organizations and mapped to sector (e.g. Transportation, Government, Fleet Operations, etc.) and subregion, then identified sectors that need further outreach
- Flagged a few long-time relationships that haven't shown up in recent reports worth reconnecting on
- Reviewed newsletter subscriber list to ensure up to date (e.g. removed bounce back emails, etc.)
- Next steps: Process to be shared with other Clean Cities Coalitions

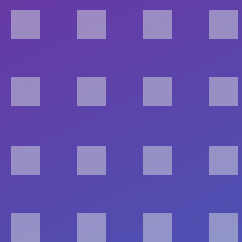

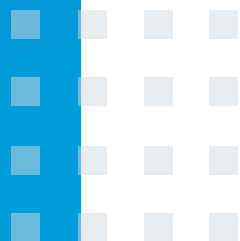

San Diego News Updates

- [Zero Emission Ride & Drive](#) (4/29/26): at Pechanga Arena.
- [City of San Diego](#) (4/20/26): The City announced more than \$16.5 million in county grant funding for **67 charging ports** at nine libraries and recreation centers.
- [San Diego County](#): The County's new **Electric Vehicle Charger Program** is accepting its first round of applications through **August 25, 2026**. It applies to **eligible private properties in unincorporated San Diego County**, including apartments with four or more units, retail sites, workplaces, schools, medical facilities and similar locations.
- [Port of San Diego](#): In June, the Port approved preliminary agreements and a coastal permit for a proposed bulk-sugar facility at the Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal. The planned operation would use **only battery-electric Class 8 trucks** to move sugar between the terminal and Otay Mesa.
- [MTS](#) (3/27/26): MTS received **\$60.4 million in state funding**, including:
 - \$12.1 million for the first phase of overhead bus charging at the Kearny Mesa Division, supporting the initial 30 battery-electric buses assigned there. Construction is anticipated to start in June 2026. **[8/3 update: project put on hold]**
 - \$48.3 million for Orange Line trolley infrastructure, signals, crossings and track improvements.
